The purpose of homework assignments is to help build responsibility, self-discipline, and life-long learning habits. Homework reinforces the days' assignments. Homework provides students with the opportunity to apply the information they have learned, complete unfinished class assignments, and develop independence. Homework is an integral part of your child's overall average.

Students **are expected to turn work in on time.** Students who turn in late assignments on a consistent basis will receive any of the following:

- partial credit
- no credit
- after school or lunch detention

Students who miss homework because of an absence will receive the opportunity to make up missed work. Students are given one calendar day for each day absent plus one extra day to turn in their work. Students should choose a Homework Buddy at the beginning of the school year, homework assignments can also be found on the school website at www.thebellacademy.com.

Parents can support BELL Academy with developing good Homework Habits by:

- Set a regular, uninterrupted study time each day
- Establish a quiet, well-lit study area
- Monitor student's organization and daily list of assignments in their agenda
- Contact teacher through your child's agenda with any difficulties your child may be having
